



Inclement Weather/Hazardous Conditions Policy & Procedures

The GSC is committed to protecting the health and safety of its skaters, while ensuring that disruption to regularly scheduled classes remains minimal. In the case of inclement weather or other emergency situation that is deemed to be unsafe for members, skaters or coaches, the GSC may cancel any scheduled classes for the affected location.

If the unsafe conditions are localized to a single arena (or other class location), efforts will be made to move the lesson to another location. If this is deemed to be infeasible, classes will be cancelled.

Cancelled classes will not be rescheduled or refunded.

The decision to cancel or relocate a class will be made jointly by the GSC Board (at least one Board member) and the coach responsible for the impacted program (Group Program Coordinator or Competitive Director). If the Group Program Coordinator or Competitive Director is unavailable, the Coaches' Board Representative will take her/his place. Every effort will be made to post the decision at least two hours in advance of the scheduled class.

In the event that a class is cancelled due to inclement weather/hazardous conditions:

- The Administrator will make every attempt to send an email to members affected by the cancellation
- The Administrator will post a notice on the GSC website homepage
- The Administrator will post a notice on the cancellation list of the radio station MAGIC 106.1
- A Board member will post a notice on the GSC Facebook, Twitter and Instagram accounts
