PreCanSkate Program

Program Requirement: Mandatory - CSA approved hockey helmets

This program is the entry level for beginners who are 3-5 years of age. Children are placed into groups according to ability and taught by Skate Canada Professional coaches and assisted by qualified Program Assistants. The focus of this program is to make learning skating fun! Skating skills taught range from learning to stand and balance to going forwards and backwards. Report Cards are issued at the end of each session.

CanSkate Program

Program Requirement: Mandatory - CSA approved hockey helmets

This is Skate Canada's flagship learn-to-skate program designed for beginners 4 and older. This program is beneficial to any skater with an interest in ice sports (figure skating, hockey, ringette). Skaters are placed in groups according to ability and taught by Skate Canada Professional coaches and assisted by qualified Program Assistants. Skaters are expected to be able to fall down and get up independently. Skaters earn badges as they learn the fundamental skating skills (forward and backward skating, stopping, turning, etc.). Report Cards are issued at the end of each session.

PrePower Program

Program Requirement: Mandatory - CSA approved hockey helmets

This program is designed for hockey and ringette players who are 5-9 years of age and already have the basic forward, backward and stopping skills (completed Stage 2 of the CanSkate program). Skaters will further enhance their basic skating skills in a power skating environment. PrePower is conducted simultaneously with CanSkate which allows for integrity within lessons. Report Cards are issued at the end of each session.

Program Requirement: Mandatory - CSA approved hockey helmets. Ages 14 and up.

This popular group program is designed for adults of all ages and ability ranges including, learn-to-skate, those looking to upgrade their skating skills as well as those who enjoy fine tuning their figure skating elements. Skaters will be given group instruction as well as individual feedback.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Cheques are payable to: Guelph Skating Club (G.S.C.). No skater will be allowed on the ice or participate in tests until a registration form has been processed and payment received.

Family Discount: A \$35 discount applies to families with 3 or more children registered on **one invoice** during the Sept. 2019 – April 2020 season. The \$35 will automatically be deducted from the invoice.

Cancellation: The G.S.C. reserves the right to change or cancel any program for which there is insufficient paid registration. In the event of any program change or cancellation the registrants will be offered a full or pro-rated refund, as appropriate.

Withdrawals: Unless for medical reasons (Doctor's Note required), withdrawal requests must be made in writing to the Club email address (gpsc.membership@gmail.com) at least 1 week prior to the start of the first skating lesson. **The Skate Canada fee and the Ontario Promotional Ticket Booklet fee will not be refunded.**

Refunds: Pro-rated refunds will only be offered for cancellation of a registration within the first 2 lessons of a skating session. The request must be made in writing to the Club email address (gpsc.membership@gmail.com) prior to the 3rd lesson. The Skate Canada fee and the Ontario Promotional Ticket Booklet fee will not be refunded.

No refund will be given for missed skating sessions or for those sessions cancelled due

to test nights, inclement weather or building maintenance problems or for any of the listed non-skate dates below.

Missed Sessions: No substitutions or make-ups are permitted for missed sessions.

Orientation: Information sessions will be provided for the parents of PreCanSkate, CanSkate, Fast Track, PrePower and PreStar skaters at the beginning of the Winter session (approx. 3rd week into session).

NSF Cheques: NSF cheques will be charged an administrative fee of \$45. Skaters cannot skate until all outstanding fees are paid in full.

G.S.C. Professional Coaches: Coaches with our Club are selected based on their qualifications and the needs of our membership. To teach Skate Canada programs, coaches must be National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) trained and/or certified and a current registered professional coaching member of Skate Canada. They must have a Skate Canada approved clearance check and positions of trust check and have a valid First Aid Certificate. A list of our Coaches can be found on our website.

Use of Helmets: It is mandatory for all participants enrolled in our PreCanSkate, CanSkate, PrePower, CanPower, Fast Track and Adult programs to wear a CSA approved hockey helmet unless they have successfully completed CanSkate Stage 5.

Volunteers: As a non-profit organization, we rely on volunteers to support the Club. Throughout the year, the Club will be contacting members requesting volunteers for specific events. Please consider volunteering when you receive these requests.

Skate Canada Registration Fee: This is a mandatory fee for all of our skaters. The yearly membership runs from September 1 through to August 31 of the following year. Being a Skate Canada sanctioned club, we are required to register every skater.

Ontario Promotional Ticket Booklet: Ontario Promotional Ticket Booklets are \$40.00. This is a mandatory fee, one per family, and is our major fundraiser for the year. The tickets are for a draw held in March 2020. The ticket booklet contains 20 \$2 tickets that you can sell to family and friends if you wish to recover your cost. Otherwise, just fill in your name on the ticket stubs and return to our office for 20 chances at winning a prize.

G.S.C. Liability: Members, parents or legal guardians of skater agree to indemnify and hold harmless the G.S.C., its Directors, Officers and their Heirs, Professional Coaches, Instructors and Members from any and all claims for damages, injuries, costs, actions, suits or proceedings, loss of property or otherwise while taking part in any program or event sanctioned or provided by the G.S.C. All members, parents or legal guardians agree to abide by the rules and regulations and bylaws of the G.S.C. as well as Skate Canada's Parent Code of Conduct.
